## Supported Child Development

Our team supports children living in Surrey with a developmental delay or disability and who may require extra support, focusing on early intervention to enable full participation in inclusive community childcare programs.

We believe in the potential of each child and recognize that every child is unique. Our goal is to empower children and families, identifying and supporting each child's individual strengths and abilities.



## Guiding Principles

- **Inclusion:** all children are supported to fully participate in community childcare programs
- **Collaborative individual planning:** each child's unique strengths and needs are recognized and supported by the team, including family
- **Child development:** children with developmental needs have access to early intervention and developmentally appropriate supports
- **Community based:** support provided in inclusive community childcare programs
- **Cultural respect:** respect for cultural diversity and practices



## What do we Help With?

- Individual planning to promote each child's unique development
  - identify and set developmental goals
  - determine strategies to support progress

## Mission, Vision, Values

Our mission continues to be helping children with special needs reach their potential.

Our vision is that children have the best opportunities to succeed in all areas of their lives.

Our values reflect that our highest priority is the well-being, safety and success of our children.

Our work is guided by the principle of family-centred care. We believe that parents are the experts when it comes to their children.

- Training and information for families and childcare providers to support each child's development

- Where necessary, additional staffing to ensure children may participate fully with peers



## Who's Eligible?

Children ages 0-19\* living in Surrey with developmental delay or disability and require extra support.

A developmental delay or disability may affect physical, cognitive, communicative, or social, emotional, behavioural development.

\*Emphasis is on early childhood development (under 6 years of age) as this is the optimal time for child development. Children 6 years and older are a continued priority and are served on an individual needs basis.
