Job Summary:

In this position you will get an opportunity to provide behavioural support services to children with Autism Spectrum Disorder and other developmental disabilities, and their families. All services are delivered with professionalism, passion, and in accordance with the policies and procedures of The Centre for Child Development. You will work to empower children, foster positive growth, and promote an inclusive environment that supports development and well-being.

Job details

- Under the direction of a clinician, provide appropriate child treatment/ intervention
- Support caregivers and provide information on appropriate resources and referrals
- Assist with organizing, scheduling, running, set-up and take-down of group sessions
- Document child progress and relevant behaviour during sessions and discuss observations and ideas with supervising clinician
- Create communication boards, visual schedules, picture symbols, and overlays for voice output communication equipment as directed by supervising therapist using computer software, digital camera, photocopier, laminator, etc.
- Effectively collaborate with team members for integrated, trauma-informed, neurodiversity-affirming care
- Use strengths-based, culturally safe approaches respecting Indigenous contexts
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications, Skills & Ability Requirements

- Diploma in a relevant field of study (i.e., Child and Youth Care, Early Childhood Education, Rehab Assistant) plus Grade 12 education
- Two years experience working as a professional directly with children with confirmed or suspected Autism and/or other developmental disabilities or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience.
- Experience implementing behavioural support plans.
- Knowledge of computer systems and applications
- Ability to communicate with families in a language common amongst clients (e.g., Punjabi, Hindi, Arabic, Mandarin, Vietnamese, Tagalog, etc.) is desirable.
- Ability to easily establish rapport with children, families, and staff
- Valid B.C. Driver's license and access to a personal vehicle for work purposes
- Criminal record check and driving history which are acceptable to the employer.
